

Item 10 – Appendix 2	Clerk's Report
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- 1 **Solar Powered Speed Controls** – From South – hedge due to be flailed over the winter but in the interim area round sign will be cut back.
- 2 **Footpaths** follow up e-mail were sent to Footpaths Officer on 7 February 2019 regarding items a-c.
 - a) **Stiles at Fulready** – the Footpaths Officer has confirmed he has, following a conversation with the Clerk, raised a maintenance order though he cannot give a date for the work.
 - b) **SD68** – WCC Footpaths officer has been asked to liaise with landowner to ensure the path is kept mown. The Footpaths Officer has not liaised with the landowner and suggests that he be re-contacted if it becomes a problem again.
 - c) Between Rookery Lane and Church The Footpaths Officer has clarified that this is the responsibility of County Highways and the Clerk will redirect the original query to that department.
- 3 **Hedgerows**
 - a) **Bottom of Kents Lane** – a request was sent to Ettington Estate Land Agent on 4 October.
- 4 **Remote Control Lighting to Tennis Courts** – Cllr Smith
- 5 **Lease Between EPC and Community Centre** – Bonnell and Co have responded and this will be an agenda item for the March meeting.
- 6 **Replacement of Planters** – pending
- 7 **WALC Community Grant** A grant application for £8,000 has been submitted in respect of Youth Project. WALC have not chosen to support the grant application but have indicated that an application focusing on a planned (rather than 'in process') project would be given consideration.
