

**1 Pavements Halford Road**

A response was received to a follow up email which stated 'Apologies, I need to speak with Jeff Morris about this if there is a way forward. This would involve a significant amount of work and may be contentious with owners of the properties behind the Halford Road so I need to discuss the best way forward'

**6 Village Clock** – The clock has been restarted and the chime suspended until such time as permanent repair can be undertaken.

**7 Playground Safety Inspection:**

- a** Replacement Toddler Swing Basket : Has been installed
- b** Safety Warning Notice for MUGA: Is ready for installation.

**8 Windows 7** Windows 10 has been installed by Broadmark Services at a cost of £84.00.

**9 Open Drain – Old Halford Road** – WCC have agreed to undertake repair despite uncertainty as to whether Severn Trent or WCC responsibility. A work order has been raised.

**10 Pothole and Raised Kerbstone at entrance to shop:** An email was sent to WCC on 31 January.

- 11 **Naming of New Road:** The applicant rejected the request to name the road Station View. A formal objection to naming it Saracen Close has been lodged.
- 12 **Footpath – Hockley Lane:** A follow up email was sent to Footpath's Officer, on 31 January, requesting letter detailing outcome of meeting.
